RE: Request Approval for Sheriff's Office Staff to Donate Accrued Sick Leave Time to Sheriff's Deputy

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### RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve Sheriff's Office staff donating accrued vacation time to the sick leave account of a Mariposa County Sheriff's Deputy with a sunset date of March 15, 2014.

A Mariposa County Sheriff's Deputy has been injured off-duty and is unable to work for an extended period of time. Because the Deputy is a fairly new employee, they do not have sufficient sick leave and vacation hours accrued to cover the time that they will be off work; hence, it is requested that Sheriff's Office staff be permitted to donate accrued vacation time to the injured employee's sick leave balance.

The Sheriff's Deputy is a full-time employee, assigned to the Sheriff's Office Public Safety Division as a Patrol Officer and is a member of the Deputy Sheriff's Association (DSA) bargaining unit.

### ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:


If donations are not permitted, the employee will run out of accrued sick and vacation time before receiving clearance to return to work.
