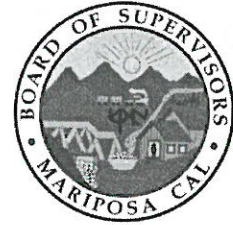

RE: 2014 Fairgrounds Interim Rental Agreement

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## **RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

Approve Interim Rental Agreement with 35-A District Agricultural Association for use of the Fairground Facilities for the Calendar Year 2014 and authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to sign the Agreement. Utilization of the Fairground Facilities shall be limited to training and other similar events and/or activities, including the Toys for Tots Program.

The 35-A District Agricultural Association is requesting approval of an Interim Rental Agreement for the use of the Fairground Facility, which is located at 5007 Fairgrounds Road, Mariposa, CA. The rental agreement will allow the Mariposa County Sheriff's Office to utilize the designated facilities during the 2014 Calendar Year at no cost to Mariposa County. The facility shall be utilized for the purpose of holding training and other events and/or activities, including the Toys for Tots Program as approved by General Manger Brian Bullis and Sheriff Doug Binnewies.

## **BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:**

The Board has approved and signed all previous Interim Rental Agreements between the Sheriff's Office and 35-A District Agricultural Association for the use of the Fairgrounds. Our current agreement expires on December 31, 2013.

## **ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:**

Failure to authorize the agreement will result in an alternate location being utilized for training and meeting purposes. The use of an alternate site may result in the Sheriff's Office having to pay for the use of other facilities.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**


