RE: Approve a Contract for Services with Mark Long Construction

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve an Agreement with Mark Long Construction for the Reclamation of Two Abandoned Mine Sites on the Tauchen Property Between Pendola Gardens, Old Toll Road and State Highway 49 in the Amount of \$58,800, and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Agreement.

On October 7, 2013, the County prepared a Request For Proposals (RFP) soliciting a fixed fee proposal for the reclaim/restore of two abandoned slate quarries on the Tauchen Property between Pendola Gardens Road, Old Toll Road and State Highway 49 North. The existing sites have been mined and are covered with shards of slate and other debris. The County has reached an agreement with the State on requirements necessary for the reclamation of the two sites, considering the requirements established by the approved Reclamation Plans.

On October 23, 2013, Public Works received two bids from contractors wishing to perform the necessary reclamation work on two mine sites located on the Tauchen Property. The lowest responsible bidder was determined to be Mark Long Construction with a lump sum bid amount of \$58,800.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

The Board could choose not to award the Agreement. The result would be that the two abandoned mine sites would not be reclaimed to acceptable conditions required by the approved Reclamation Plans and an agreement with the state.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Funds are allocated in Mariposa Aggregate Fund. Additional funding will be allocated in the Mariposa Decco Planning Fund, scheduled for December 10, 2013.
