RE: Approve a Contract for Services with Teichert Construction

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve a Contract for Services with Teichert Construction for the Mt. Bullion Cutoff Reconstruction, Phase 2 in the Not To Exceed Amount of \$786,490 and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Contract.

During the bid opening, it was noted that only one of the three bidders included the contractor's license numbers for their subcontractors. It was also noted that county specifications did not specify that they are required to submit that information. Since the project is funded under the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) with oversight from Caltrans, staff consulted with Caltrans Local Assistance staff for a recommendation. They recommended that staff request the contractor to provide the subcontractors' license numbers and award the project to the apparent low bidder unless additional discrepancies were identified in their bid. No additional discrepancies have been identified. A condition of the STIP funding is that the contract be awarded prior to December 31, 2014.

The Mt. Bullion Cutoff Road reconstruction is funded under the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) with a budget allocation of \$2,149,000 and received approval at the June 25, 2014, California Transportation Commission meeting.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On December 10, 2013, The Board of Supervisors' adopted the 2014 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP).

On October 28, 2014 Resolution #2014-564 the Board of Supervisors approved the plans and specifications and authorized the Public Works Director to solicit bid proposals and award the project to the lowest responsible bidder.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve; the project would not proceed and funding would be lost.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Funds in the amount of \$2,149,000 are allocated in the STIP County Road Project budget 511-1311-781-0649. This project is funded 100% with no County match required.
