Resolution authorizing Chairman to sign Addendum to Legal Services Agreement with Gary L. Collings and David A. Smothers for indigent defense services effective August 17, 1999 and ending on August 16, 2000 and approving budget action increasing the Indigent Defense budget (\$6,000).

BOARD ACTION: Discussion was held with Jeff Green, County Counsel, and he advised that detailed information will be kept for review for consideration of renewing the contract in the future. (M)Balmain, (S)Reilly, Res. 00-61 adopted/Ayes: Reilly, Balmain, Stewart, Parker; Noes: Pickard. Jeff Green noted that these types of programs (in this case a revision to the contract as a result of the implementation of the Drug Court) and grant programs have impacts on the costs to the General Fund. Janet Hogan, County Administrative Officer, noted that the Drug Court may not result in a lower jail population and incarceration costs.
