RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

(Policy Item: Yes ___ No XXX)

Adopt resolution clarifying the commitment to construction of the Greeley Hill Sidewalks:

1. Apply \$95,202 of Zone of Benefit Funds to construct the Greeley Hill Sidewalks, in the 2000/2001 FY
2. Move the \$ 95,202 of Proposition 116 Funds previously committed to the Greeley Hill Sidewalks to the Mariposa Town Sidewalk project.

This action will allow all of the Proposition 116 funds to be expended on the Mariposa Town Sidewalks

Encumbrance of the Proposition 116 Funds must be completed by March 30, 2000. The Greeley Hill Sidewalk will not be ready to bid until summer **BUT** The Greeley Hill Sidewalks were included in the Proposition 116 grant scope, and must still be completed per the Proposition 116 fund transfer agreement. This item is a clarification of action taken on February 22, 2000, where the Board authorized \$212,402 of Zone of Benefit funds, but stated that the Greeley Hill Project would still be funded from Proposition 116. This action will swap the Prop 116 funds for Zone of Benefit funds in Greeley Hill.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board has requested completion of the sidewalk projects for several years. The Board included Greeley Hill as a location for sidewalks on routes to school as part of the Proposition 116 fund projects May 4, 1993, Resolution 93-8. The Board acted to fund the Mariposa Town Sidewalks on County Roads February 22, 2000, with the commitment to construct the Greeley Hill sidewalks in summer 2000.
