The following are the purposes and objectives of the Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board as of August 19, 2015:

- Advise the Board of Supervisors and Behavioral Health and Recovery Services on acceptance of policies and goals of county alcohol and drug programs.
- Participate in the county-wide alcohol and drug program planning process.
- Provide recommendations regarding alcohol and drug programs to the Board of Supervisors, Behavioral Health and Recovery Services, the Advisory Board members, and individuals in the community.
- Review the scope of alcohol and drug programs in county-funded agencies/departments and Mariposa County communities at large.
- Review the evaluations of the community alcohol and drug programs to improve communication on services, facilities, and special programs.
- Encourage and educate the public to understand the nature and impact of alcohol and drug programs.
- Promote support throughout the County for the development and implementation of effective alcohol and drug programs.
- Ensure citizens of all ages are involved, including elders and youth as well as professionals, are involved in all stages of the process with membership to the Alcohol and Drug Advisory board, leading to the formation and adoption of the County alcohol and drug program plans.
- Support the development of a lending library of alcohol and drug recovery resources, i.e. books on tape, videos and DVDs available through the public library.
