RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Consider commitment to reimburse a private party for a portion of costs on a privately constructed bridge across Mariposa Creek from Joe Howard Street to Antone Road (\$10,000); refer to Attachment #1 a letter of request from George Greenamyre which is self explanatory. Public Works recommends serious consideration of the request as it would provide an affordable means of implementing a crossing for the future Mariposa Creek project.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On April 4, 1999, Mr. Greemamyre requested that the County participate in this project by providing engineering for the bridge and by accepting the bridge into the County-maintained system. The Board referred the matter back to Public Works to obtain more information and work with Mr. Greenamyre on possible joint venture. Complications arose with the County's direct involvement in that such would make the bridge a public project with all of the attendant costs and requirements. Mr. Greenamyre has since chosen to pursue the bridge as a completely private project.

**RE: Mariposa Bridge over Mariposa Creek at Joe Howard Street**

Dear Mr. Edwards:

As you know, we intend to construct a new bridge as described above. Our hope is to complete the bridge prior to winter. The bridge will consist of an engineered, pre-cast concrete arch structure. There will be five 6' wide pre-cast sections for total bridge width of 30'. This will accommodate two 12' travel lanes plus eventual curb and gutter improvements for a Town Class II road. Our estimated cost to complete the project is \$60,000. The bridge will be built within the existing dedicated public access easement.

You have expressed an interest in having us add one more 6' section to the bridge. It is my understanding that such would allow for the addition of a pedestrian/bicycle crossing as part of the structure. I believe this would be consistent with the long-term plan the County has for extension of the Mariposa Creek Parkway to Joe Howard Street. Our estimated cost for the additional 6' width is \$10,000. I am hereby requesting that the County commit to reimbursement of up to \$10,000 of our cost to include this additional bridge width. At this time, I am not requesting that the County accept the bridge into the County road system.

Would you please bring my request to the Board of Supervisors at your earliest convenience so that we may plan our construction accordingly? Thank you for your assistance regarding this matter.
