RECOMMENDED ACTION AND JUSTIFICATION: (Policy Item: Yes ___ No XX)

Adopt the attached resolution pursuant to AB1661 and SB 711. The State appropriated \$150,000,000 to cities and counties to offset some of the loss local jurisdictions suffer from the shift of property tax revenues to the Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund. One-half of those funds is allocated based on relative population of the cities and counties. Mariposa County has received \$35,752 which represents our share of the monies as outlined in Section 8 of AB 1661. The county is required to adopt the attached resolution to be eligible for the other half of the monies appropriated in the 1999 Budget Act. This is outlined in Section 7 of AB 1661 and SB 711.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

This is new legislation that the county is acting upon for the first time.

ALLOCATIONS TO THE EDUCATIONAL REVENUE AUGMENTATION FUND

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 86 (SB711), section 7, the county auditor has reported to the State Controller and the Director of Finance the total amount of ad valorem property tax revenue allocated from the county's Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund (ERAF) to the school district and superintendent of schools for the 1998-99 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Mariposa County will allocate its share of the appropriated money subject to this section in accordance with Chapter 84 (Assembly Bill 1661), Section 7, subdivision (c); and

WHEREAS, Mariposa County will not, in connection with preparation of this Resolution and its attachments consistent with either paragraph (1) or (2) and subdivision(c) of Chapter 86, (Senate Bill 711), Section 7, make any claim for reimbursement of state-mandated costs.




