

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 784

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEE SCHEDULES
FOR COUNTY DEPARTMENTS
(Not to be Codified)

WHEREAS, Departments within the County of Mariposa need to revise existing fee schedules to cover increased costs, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has held a public hearing as part of the process of adopting these fee schedules;

WHEREAS, Fee Schedule Ordinance No. 776, the County's first ordinance to establish fee schedules through the public hearing process, contained Fee Schedules identified by Departmental Exhibits, i.e. Exhibits "A" through "F", with each letter representing a separate Department/Division function. This ordinance will continue the lettering process to identify any new Departments with fee schedules i.e., Exhibit "G", "H", etc. Fee schedules being rescinded and replaced will reference the previous listings i.e., Exhibit "E2", "E3", etc.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: The fee schedules for the following Departments, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, have been reviewed by a public hearing and are hereby adopted as the following Exhibits:





FEE SCHEDULE

Unless listed below, fees for building permits will be based on the 1988 edition of the Uniform Building Code as published by the International Conference of Building Officials. Unless listed below, valuations used to compute the fees will be taken from the most recent issue of the "Building Standards" magazine published by the International Conference of Building Officials.

Unless otherwise specified, a \$15.00 permit issuance (automation) fee shall be assessed in addition to the following fees:

A Plan Check Fee of 65% of the Building Permit Fee shall be assessed. A fee of \$30.00 for checking the California Title 24 energy requirements shall be assessed. Excessive plan checking shall be billed at a rate of \$30.00 per hour or fraction thereof.

Whenever an inspection is requested and the inspector finds that the work requested to be inspected is not completed or accessible for inspection, a reinspection fee of \$30.00 shall be assessed and must be paid prior to scheduling of any further inspections. Whenever a correction to work is issued and an inspection of the corrections is requested and found not to comply, a reinspection fee of \$30.00 shall be assessed prior to scheduling any further inspections.

Special Inspections shall be billed at a rate of \$30.00 per hour or fraction thereof, with a two hour minimum.

Permits may be renewed for a period of one year by paying a fee of \$25.00.

Enclosed or unenclosed buildings for agricultural and livestock use, greater than 400 sq. ft. and less than 5,000 sq. ft., shall pay a \$15.00 issuance fee.

For conversion construction of nonhabitable space to habitable space, the fee shall be based on the valuation of the work done, as specified by the model codes.

Encroachment permits shall be issued at a fee of \$60.00.

No permit shall be issued for less than \$30.00 (including Issuance Fee).

STATE FIRE MARSHAL SERVICES FEES
(Mariposa County Code)

15.11.020 State fire marshal services fees.

The county has entered into an agreement with the state fire marshal's office to provide timely inspections for commercial and industrial projects based upon service fees, and the costs incurred for these services shall be collected from the developer as "state fire marshal service fees" with the following provisions:

A. Any time that the state fire marshal's services are provided to county for an industrial or commercial project wherein the state fire marshal charges the county for their inspection services, then in that event the applicant for the building permit shall pay to the county the sum of fifty dollars (\$55) per hour for all hours billed to the county by the state fire marshal for the applicant's project.

B. At the time of filing an application which is accepted as complete for processing, the applicant shall make a five hundred dollars (\$500) deposit with the building division which shall be billed against the developer by county at the rate of \$55 per hour for each hour billed to county by the state.

C. If the final inspection fees for the state fire marshal's services are less than \$500 billed at the rate of \$55 per hour then the county shall refund any of the original deposit, or at the applicant's request apply the balance left to other permit fees.

D. If the final billing exceeds the minimum \$500 deposit, then in that event the applicant shall pay the balance due and owing to the county at the rate of \$55 per hour before a certificate of occupancy is issued by the county.

E. The building division of public works department shall be responsible for the collection and reimbursement of any funds as outlined above.

LAND DIVISION FEE SCHEDULE

JUSTIFICATION

1. All Land Divisions with road and other improvements require inspection by the County Engineer-Surveyor.
2. Planning Commission requirements for improvements must be satisfied prior to recordation of the map.
3. Man-hours, travel and testing procedures should be reimbursed to the County on an actual cost basis.
4. Inspection reports must be generated on each Land Division.
5. Any improvement plan check will be covered.

LAND DIVISION INSPECTION FEES

1. The fees will be 5% of the total cost of improvements.
2. A MINIMUM FEE of \$100.00 will be charged.

MAP CHECKING FEE SCHEDULE

JUSTIFICATION

1. Map Checking is mandated by State law (Land Surveyor's Act & Subdivision Map Act).
2. State law, as noted in No. 1, above, allows the County to recover reasonable costs for map checking services.
3. Parcel maps and final maps require Board of Supervisors (BOS) approval. Consequently, a BOS agenda item must be prepared and presented for each of these maps. The proposed fees will recover the cost for these technical and administrative activities currently being paid from the Road funds.

DEFINITIONS

1. Record of Survey Map: A map depicting the results of a field survey based on data either previously recorded or on file. A record of survey map shall not be used to divide property not previously divided.
2. Parcel Map: Commonly referred to as a minor subdivision map, this map is used to divide property into four or less parcels after approval by the Planning Commission. The map is required to show the location of all corners used to determine boundaries as well as any offers of dedication required by the Planning Commission.
3. Final Map: Commonly referred to as a Major Subdivision Map, this map is used to divide property in five or more parcels after approval by the Planning Commission. It is required that the map show all corners used to determine boundaries as well as any offers of dedication required by the Planning Commission.

MISCELLANEOUS FEES SCHEDULE

JUSTIFICATION

1. The Planning Department requires input from Public Works regarding approval of Tentative Maps and other miscellaneous actions.
2. Some of these requests for input necessitate field inspections by Public Works personnel.
3. Written reports are normally developed for the Public Works recommendations.
4. Sometimes, additional information is requested by the Planning Department that requires additional field inspection by Public Works personnel.

ZONES OF BENEFIT FEE SCHEDULE

JUSTIFICATION

1. Public Works staff time is devoted to the development of Zones of Benefit requirements with an average time requirement of 12 hours.
2. The services provided are of direct benefit to the applicants.
3. Several inspections are required for proper development of the zones.
4. Map checking and calculations are required for proper development of the zones.

1. A Public Interest Zone of Benefit is a zone determined by the Director of Public Works to be of public interest and not related to a new development.
2. A Public Interest Zone of Benefit may, upon approval of the Director of Public Works, pay a \$200.00 deposit with the remaining fees to be diverted to the first year's property tax. The approval shall be based upon the Director's opinion that the public interest zone of benefit is viable and likely to succeed and benefits multiple members of the community.
