

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 737

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE  
RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS  
TO THE MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT  
AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO ELECTION  
(Not to be Codified)

WHEREAS, the Mariposa County Resource Conservation District has requested the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors to appoint directors for three positions on the Resource Conservation District Board pursuant to Mariposa County Resource Conservation District Resolution 1-88, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to assist the Resource Conservation District with these appointments;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County a political subdivision of the State of California does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I:

1. Pursuant to Section 9314(b) of the Public Resources Code, the Mariposa County Resource Conservation District has, as an alternative to the election of directors, presented its Resolution No. 1-88, a copy of which is attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and by this reference incorporated herein, requesting the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors to officially appoint its directors, and

2. Pursuant to Section 9314(b) of the Public Resources Code, three people have formally applied for Directorships in the Mariposa County Resource Conservation District, the County Clerk has certified that each individual application contains the signatures of ten qualified voters of the District, and therefore the following candidates have met all requirements for appointment by the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ann Mendershausen
2. Robert Binnewies
3. Walter Bunt

3. The Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County with the authority vested in it by the above-cited Section hereby appoints Ann Mendershausen, Robert Binnewies and Walter Bunt to vacancies on the Board of Directors of the Mariposa County Resource Conservation District for a term of four years. The term of office for these three Directorships shall begin on Friday, November 25, 1988 and end on the last Friday of November, 1992.

SECTION II: This ordinance is deemed an urgency ordinance and


shall become effective immediately for the following reasons:

1. California Government Code Section 25123(a) authorizes the Board of Supervisors to take action which takes immediate effect wherein said action deals with matters relating to an election, and

2. The Resource Conservation District has a meeting scheduled for December 14, 1988 and without these appointments the Board of Directors will not have a quorum to conduct its necessary business.



RESOLUTION 1-88


