

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE No. 636

AMENDING TITLE I OF THE MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE  
BY ADDING CHAPTER 1.30 ENTITLED  
"DIVERSION OF MISDEMEANOR OFFENDERS"

WHEREAS, California Penal Code Sections 1001.50 through 1001.55 provides for a program wherein first-time misdemeanor offenders may be diverted from the penal system, and

WHEREAS, in order for the County of Mariposa to participate in the diversion of misdemeanor offenders, an ordinance must be adopted by the Board of Supervisors permitting the institution of such a program, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County finds it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Mariposa County to divert selected first-time misdemeanor offenders out of the penal system;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Board of Supervisors does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Chapter 1.30 of Title I of the Mariposa County Code is added to read in its entirety as follows:

"Chapter 1.30


The board of supervisors hereby adopts by reference the provisions of Chapter 2.9, commencing with Sections

1 1001.50 through and including Section 1001.55 of Title 6, of  
2 Part 2, of the Penal Code of the State of California, together  
3 with future revision thereof, regarding the diversion of  
4 selected misdemeanor offenders."


5 SECTION II: This Ordinance has been deemed an urgency ordinance  
6 by the Judges of the Superior and Justice Courts and the District  
7 Attorney of the County of Mariposa as there are various mis-  
8 demeanor offenders presently in the penal system of the County  
9 of Mariposa that should be processed through the diversionary  
10 program immediately thereby serving the best interests of the  
11 citizens of the County of Mariposa. Therefore, this ordinance  
12 shall be passed as an urgency ordinance and become effective  
13 immediately upon passage by a four-fifths vote of the Board  
14 of Supervisors, pursuant to Government Code Section 25123(d).
