## MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 641

AMENDING TITLE 8, HEALTH AND SAFETY,
BY ADDING CHAPTER 8.40 ENTITLED
"UNDERGROUND STORAGE OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES"

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARIPOSA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of California does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Chapter 8, of the Mariposa County Code entitled "Health and Safety" is hereby amended by adding Chapter 8.40, entitled "Underground Storage of Hazardous Substances", to provide for the County's assumption of responsibility relating to inspection and permitting of underground tanks used for the storage of hazardous substances. Chapter 8.40 shall read in its entirety as follows:

8.40.010 Implementation of chapter.

 A. The County of Mariposa hereby assumes responsibility for the implementation of Chapter 6.7, of Division 20, of the California Health and Safety Code, relating to storage of hazardous substances in underground tanks in accordance with Sections 25282 and 25288 of the Health and Safety Code.

of the Health and Safety Code.

B. Sections 25284 and 25284.1 of the Health and Safety Code are hereby adopted by reference.

8.40.020 Enforcement procedures.

A. The Mariposa County Health Department is hereby designated as the enforcement body of the County and shall comply with the notice and consultation

provisions of Section 25282 of the Health and Safety 1 Code. The Mariposa County Health Department shall 2 enforce the provisions contained in Chapter 6.7, of Division 20, of the Health and Safety Code at such time 3 as the enforcement guidelines are presented to County by the State of California."
