

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE No. 585

RESTRICTIONS ON SOLID WASTE
DUMPING IN MARIPOSA COUNTY

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of Mariposa County does hereby ordain
as follows:

SECTION I: Section 8.36.150 is added to the Mariposa County
Code to read as follows:

"8.36.150 Dumping by other persons or entities. Dump-
ing of solid waste and refuse of any type in transfer sites
and dumps owned, controlled or operated by Mariposa County,
by any person or entity not expressly permitted under the
provisions of this chapter is prohibited and shall consti-
tute an infraction punishable under Chapter 1.20 of this
code."

SECTION II: Section 8.36.160 is added to the Mariposa County
Code to read as follows:

"8.36.160 Persons and entities permitted. The follow-
ing persons and entities are expressly permitted to dump
solid waste and refuse, in compliance with the regulations
of this chapter, in transfer sites and dumps in Mariposa
County:

A. Residents of Mariposa County bearing identification
establishing residency.

B. Owners of real property in Mariposa County bearing
identification and listed on the property rolls, and their
tenants, lessees and agents.

C. Commercial refuse collectors holding a valid permit
issued by Mariposa County under the regulations of this



2 D. Persons or entities who have entered into contracts
3 or agreements with Mariposa County for the use of dump and
4 transfer sites."


5 SECTION III: This ordinance shall become effective thirty
6 (30) days from the date of final passage pursuant to Government
7 Code Section 25123.
