

1 MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE 489

2 Before the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa,
3 State of California

4 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE
5 A "MARIPOSA COUNTY CODE". A CODIFICATION OF
6 THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF MARIPOSA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA,
7 TOGETHER WITH SECONDARY CODES REFERRED TO THEREIN, NAMELY
8 "STANDARDS ADOPTED BY THE UNITED STATES PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE
9 ON FEBRUARY 5, 1946, FOR DRINKING AND CULINARY WATER
10 SUPPLIED BY CARRIERS SUBJECT TO
11 FEDERAL QUARANTINE REGULATIONS" AND AMENDMENTS THERETO
12 MADE ON FEBRUARY 28, 1962, AND
13 MARIPOSA COUNTY IMPROVEMENT STANDARDS
14 FOR MINOR SUBDIVISIONS

15 WHEREAS, the California State Legislature has provided
16 for the codification and publication of the permanent and general
17 ordinances of counties, cities, and towns in Sections 50022.1 -
18 50022.8 and 50022.10 of the California Code Annotated; and

19 WHEREAS, the Book Publishing Company, Seattle,
20 Washington, has compiled, edited, and published a codification of
21 the permanent and general ordinances of Mariposa County,
22 California; and

23 WHEREAS, there have been filed and there are now on
24 file in the Office of the County Clerk, for public inspection,
25 three copies of a document entitled "Mariposa County Code", to-
26 gether with three copies of each of the secondary codes therein
27 adopted by reference.

28 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa,
State of California, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: ADOPTION. Pursuant to the provisions of
Sections 50022.1 - 50022.8 and 50022.10 of the California Code
Annotated, there is hereby adopted the "Mariposa County Code" as
published by Book Publishing Company, Seattle, Washington, to-
gether with those secondary codes adopted by reference as

1 authorized by the California State Legislature, save and except
2 those portions of the secondary codes as are deleted or modified
3 by the provisions of the "Mariposa County Code".

4 SECTION 2: TITLE; CITATION; REFERENCE. This Code
5 shall be known as the "Mariposa County Code", and it shall be
6 sufficient to refer to said Code as the "Mariposa County Code" in
7 any prosecution for the violation of any provision thereof or in
8 any proceeding at law or equity. It shall be sufficient to
9 designate any ordinance adding to, amending, correcting, or
10 repealing all or any part or portion thereof as an addition,
11 amendment to, correction, or repeal of the "Mariposa County Code".
12 Further reference may be had to the titles, chapters, sections,
13 and subsections of the "Mariposa County Code", and such references
14 shall apply to that numbered title, chapter, section, or subsec-
15 tion as it appears in the Code.

16 SECTION 3: CODIFICATION AUTHORITY. This Code consists
17 of all the regulatory and penal ordinances and certain of the ad-
18 ministrative ordinances of Mariposa County, California, codified
19 pursuant to the provisions of Sections 50022.1 - 50022.8 and
20 50022.10 of the California Code Annotated.

21 SECTION 4: ORDINANCES PASSED PRIOR TO ADOPTION OF THE
22 CODE. The last ordinance included in this Code was Ordinance 475
23 passed February 7, 1978. The following ordinances, passed subse-
24 quent to Ordinance 475, but prior to the adoption of this Code,
25 are hereby adopted and made a part of this Code: Ordinances 476,
26 366-E, 366-F, 477, 478, 478A, 479, 480, 481, 482, 483, 484, and
27 485, 486, 487, and 488.

SECTION 5: REFERENCE APPLIES TO ALL AMENDMENTS.

Whenever a reference is made to this Code as the "Mariposa County Code" or to any portion thereof, or to any ordinance of Mariposa County, California, the reference shall apply to all amendments, corrections, and additions heretofore, now or hereafter made.

SECTION 6: TITLE, CHAPTER, AND SECTION HEADINGS.

Title, chapter, and section headings contained herein shall not be deemed to govern, limit, modify, or in any manner affect the scope, meaning, or intent of the provisions of any title, chapter, or section hereof.

SECTION 7: REFERENCE TO SPECIFIC ORDINANCES. The pro-

visions of this Code shall not in any manner affect matters of record which refer to, or are otherwise connected with, ordinances which are therein specifically designated by number or otherwise and which are included within the Code, but such reference shall be construed to apply to the corresponding provisions contained within this Code.

SECTION 8: EFFECT OF CODE ON PAST ACTIONS AND OBLIGA-

TIONS. Neither the adoption of this Code nor the repeal or amendment hereby of any ordinance or part or portion of any ordinance of the County shall in any manner affect the prosecution for violations of ordinances, which violations were committed prior to the effective date hereof, nor be construed as a waiver of any license, fee, or penalty at said effective date due and unpaid under such ordinances, nor be construed as affecting any of the provisions of such ordinances relating to the collection of any license, fee, or penalty, or the penal provisions

1 applicable to any violation thereof, nor to affect the validity
2 of any bond or cash deposit in lieu thereof required to be posted,
3 filed, or deposited pursuant to any ordinance and all rights and
4 obligations thereunder appertaining shall continue in full force
5 and effect.

6 SECTION 9: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Code shall become
7 effective on the date the ordinance adopting this Code as the
8 "Mariposa County Code" shall become effective.

9 SECTION 10: CONSTITUTIONALITY. If any section, sub-
10 section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Code is for any
11 reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision
12 shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
13 Code. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would
14 have passed this Code, and each section, subsection, sentence,
15 clause, and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one
16 or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases had
17 been declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if for any reason
18 this Code should be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then
19 the original ordinance or ordinances shall be in full force and
20 effect.


