

MARIPOSA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 457

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

An ordinance to regulate parking recorded as Ordinance No. 227 enacted on the 5th day of September, 1962, and all amendments thereto, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2

An ordinance to regulate parking recorded as Ordinance No. 266 enacted on the 4th day of January, 1966, and all amendments thereto, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3

An ordinance to regulate parking recorded as Ordinance No. 309 enacted on the 6th day of May, 1969, and all amendments thereto, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4

A resolution to regulate parking recorded as Resolution No. 72-39 enacted on the 18th day of April, 1972, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5

There is hereby established a loading zone on each side of Charles Street in the Town of Mariposa, County of Mariposa, State of California, commencing at a point ninety (90) feet south of Sixth Street and extending thirty (30) feet southerly therefrom.

During the hours between 10 A.M. and 2 P.M. daily, except Sunday, parking in the above-described zone shall be limited for the purpose of loading and unloading vehicles.

SECTION 6

No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, in any of the following places:

- (a) Within fifteen (15) feet of the entrance to any theatre.
- (b) Within twenty-five (25) feet of the entrance to any fire station.
- (c) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped, parked, or standing at the curb or edge of a highway.
- (d) On Charles Street in the Town of Mariposa, within fifteen (15) feet either side of a point one hundred thirty-five (135) feet southerly from the curbs at the corner of Sixth and Charles Streets, except for the purpose of loading or unloading freight. This limitation shall apply only between the hours of 8 A.M. and 6 P.M. and does not apply on Sundays or holidays.

SECTION 7

The following motor vehicle parking regulations and restrictions shall apply to the following streets and roads in the Town of Mariposa:

- (a) On Fifth Street between Charles Street and Bullion Street parallel parking shall be permitted on the north side, and there shall be no parking on the south side.
- (b) On Sixth Street between Charles Street and the Mariposa Creek Bridge right angle parking shall be

1 permitted on the south side, and no parking shall  
2 be permitted on the north side.

3 (c) On Sixth Street between Charles Street and Bullion  
4 Street diagonal parking shall be permitted on the  
5 south side, and no parking shall be permitted on  
6 the north side except that motor vehicles may be  
7 parked primarily on privately owned property on the  
8 north side, provided no part of any vehicle so  
9 parked shall extend onto or across or into the por-  
10 tion of Sixth Street normally used for motor vehicu-  
11 lar travel.

12 (d) On Seventh Street between Charles and Bullion  
13 Streets diagonal motor vehicle parking shall be  
14 permitted on the north side immediately adjacent to  
15 the Yosemite Market property only.

16 (e) On Sixth Street from the intersection of Mariposa  
17 Street and Sixth Street extending from said inter-  
18 section one hundred twenty-five (125) feet south-  
19 west, no parking shall be allowed on the northwest  
20 side of Sixth Street.

21 SECTION 8

22 On Sixth Street between Charles Street and the Mariposa  
23 Creek Bridge parking on the north side thereof is prohibited;  
24 parallel parking only is permitted on the south side thereof be-  
25 tween Mariposa Creek Bridge and a line parallel with and situated  
26 sixty-nine (69) feet west of the westerly line of Charles Street  
27 (State Route 140 sign); a loading zone, to be used by commercial  
28 vehicles only while loading or unloading merchandise and while

1 parked parallel with the southerly line of Sixth Street as close  
2 thereto as reasonably possible, is hereby established on the south  
3 side of Sixth Street between the westerly line of Charles Street  
4 (State Route 140 sign) and a line sixty-nine (69) feet west of and  
5 parallel with said westerly line of Charles Street.

6 SECTION 9

7 On Eighth Street between Jones and Bullion Streets  
8 diagonal parking shall be permitted on the north side of privately  
9 owned property for not over five (5) motor vehicles at any one  
10 time, between a point thirty (30) feet east of the southwest block  
11 corner of Block 35 of the Town of Mariposa and a point one hundred  
12 six and five-tenths (106.5) feet east of said southwest block cor-  
13 ner, except for six (6) feet at the sidewalk entrance to the front  
14 of the Post Office building, provided that no part of any vehicle  
15 so parked shall extend onto or across or into the portion of Eighth  
16 Street normally used for vehicular travel. No parking shall be  
17 permitted at any time between a point one hundred six and five-  
18 tenths (106.5) feet east of said southwest block corner and the  
19 intersection of Eighth and Jones Streets on the north side of  
20 Eighth Street, and no parking shall be permitted at any time on the  
21 south side of Eighth Street between Jones and Bullion Street.

22 On Bullion Street between the southwest block corner of  
23 Block 35 of the Town of Mariposa and a point one hundred twenty-six  
24 (126) feet north of said block corner, no parking shall be per-  
25 mitted on either side of the easterly half of Bullion Street pre-  
26 sently used for vehicular travel.

27 SECTION 10

28 It is unlawful for any firm, person, or corporation to

1 park or stop a vehicle or cause the same to be parked or stopped,  
2 for a period in excess of two (2) hours between the hours of 9 A.M.  
3 and 5 P.M., Sundays and holidays excepted, on Fifth, Sixth, or  
4 Seventh Streets between the east curb line of State Route 140 and  
5 the west curb line of Bullion Street in the Town of Mariposa.

6 SECTION 11

7 There is hereby established a bus loading zone on the  
8 north side of Tenth Street in the Town of Mariposa, County of  
9 Mariposa, State of California, commencing twenty (20) feet from the  
10 intersection of Highway 140 and Tenth Street running westerly for  
11 sixty (60) feet to Jessie Street.

12 Parking in the above-described zone shall be limited for  
13 the purpose of bus parking and the loading and unloading of bus  
14 passengers.

15 SECTION 12

16 It is unlawful for truck and trailer combinations or  
17 tractor and trailer combinations exceeding forty (40) feet in  
18 length to travel on the Mariposa County Highway known as Boneyard  
19 Road.

20 SECTION 13

21 Every violation of the provisions of this ordinance is  
22 an infraction punishable as provided in Vehicle Code Section 42001.

23 SECTION 14

24 The Mariposa County Road Commissioner is hereby author-  
25 ized and directed to immediately determine and mark on the road  
26 surface of the above-mentioned streets and roads the number and  
27 position of diagonal and right-angle parking spaces permitted under  
28 this ordinance, and to post in conspicuous places along said

1 streets and roads signs which will adequately notify the public of  
2 the parking regulations imposed thereon under this ordinance.

3 SECTION 15

4 The Mariposa County Road Commissioner or any duly  
5 authorized peace officer may remove or cause removal of any vehicle  
6 parked on the above-mentioned streets and roads in violation of  
7 the terms of this ordinance and store the said vehicle, or cause it  
8 to be stored at the expense of the owner or operator thereof, when-  
9 ever said Road Commissioner or duly authorized peace officer finds  
10 that such vehicle so parked will constitute a serious traffic  
11 hazard. Towing and storage charges imposed by the firm or person  
12 who tows or stores such vehicle.

13 SECTION 16


14 The Board of Supervisors hereby finds that the lack of  
15 regulation of motor vehicle parking on the above-mentioned streets  
16 and roads, and the parking of motor vehicles on both sides of the  
17 above-mentioned streets and roads, has caused a dangerous traffic  
18 condition thereon, and, that in order to remove said dangerous  
19 condition and provide for the safe passage of motor vehicles along  
20 the said streets and roads, it is necessary that the above pro-  
21 visions of this ordinance be placed in effect immediately. This  
22 ordinance shall take effect immediately as an emergency measure,  
23 and a true copy thereof shall be published in the MARIPOSA GAZETTE  
24 within fifteen (15) days.
