



1 inspection at all reasonable times, or, in lieu thereof, a sign  
2 bearing the applicable fees and charges shall be posted in a  
3 conspicuous place at or near the entrance to said disposal site.

4 (c) All schedules of fees and charges heretofore  
5 established by ordinance or resolution of the Board are hereby  
6 expressly continued in effect until altered, amended, or revoked  
7 as herein provided.

8 (d) The Board may from time to time, by ordinance or  
9 by resolution establish such rules and regulations with regard  
10 to the establishment, maintenance, and operation of refuse dis-  
11 posal areas within the County of Mariposa as may be necessary  
12 or desirable in the interest of public health, safety, and  
13 welfare, and may in like manner alter, amend, or revoke the same.


14 (e) A licensed refuse collector shall not be required  
15 to handle any garbage or refuse collection container with a  
16 capacity in excess of 33 gallons or a weight, when filled with  
17 refuse or garbage, in excess of 85 pounds."


18 SECTION II: The Board of Supervisors hereby finds that  
19 during the spring and summer months large numbers of people, in  
20 excess of one and one-half million, visit Mariposa County as  
21 summer residents, as tourists, campers, hunters, fishermen, or  
22 in pursuit of recreation; that many of said persons visit  
23 Yosemite National Park and enter or leave Yosemite National Park  
24 via Highway 41; that the burden of providing proper disposal of  
25 refuse and garbage within the County varies from area to area  
26 and in some areas of the County bears no reasonable relation  
27 to the population or taxable property within such areas of the  
28 County; that it is indispensable to the public health, safety,  
29 and welfare of the inhabitants of Mariposa County and members  
30 of the public visiting in the County from outside the County of  
31 Mariposa to adequately provide for the establishment and main-  
32 tenance of refuse disposal areas in the County; that it is

1 necessary to impose fees and charges for the use of County owned  
2 or operated refuse disposal areas in those portions of the County  
3 which experience the largest use by visitors from outside the  
4 County; that refuse disposal facilities formerly existing in  
5 the Wawona area within the boundaries of Yosemite National Park  
6 are no longer available for use; that the existing Fish Camp  
7 Disposal Area is inadequate to meet the needs of either the  
8 residents of Fish Camp and Wawona or the needs of visitors to  
9 that area; that the County of Mariposa is in the process of  
10 establishing and maintaining a new refuse disposal area, including  
11 an all-weather road thereto, to meet the refuse disposal needs  
12 of the residents of Fish Camp and Wawona and visitors to those  
13 areas; that it is necessary to impose fees and charges for use  
14 of the existing Fish Camp Disposal Area and the planned new Fish  
15 Camp Disposal Area in order to partially meet the costs of estab-  
16 lishment, maintenance and operation thereof. For the foregoing  
17 reasons, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its  
18 enactment as an emergency measure for the immediate protection  
19 of the public's health and safety, within the meaning of sub-section  
20 (d) of Government Code Section 25123 and of the Constitution of  
21 the State of California.
