ORDINANCE NO. 122

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES NOS. 106, 107 and 117, KNOWN AS THE "SALARY ORDINANCE OF 1941."

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 11 of Ordinance No. 106, Section 8 of Ordinance No. 107 and Section 11 of Ordinance No. 117 are hereby amended to read as follows:

The salary of the superintendent of schools shall be Two Thousand Four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars per annum. In addition thereto, said superintendent of schools shall be allowed actual traveling expenses incurred in visting schools of the county and for educational work connected therewith, including annual expenses incurred in attending annual convention of superintendents of schools, not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars per annum.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after thirty days of its passage.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa on the 1st day of June, 1942, by the following vote, to-wit:
