

ORDINANCE NO. 165

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa,
do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 142 is hereby
amended to read as follows:

6. Where any officer or employee of the County
of Mariposa [is obliged in the discharge of his duties
to travel within or without the County of Mariposa,]
unless a specific allowance for such travel and in-
cidental expenses is specifically provided, he shall
receive (1) the sum of twelve (12) cents per mile for
each mile traveled on trips wholly within the County,
and (2) the sum of eight (8) cents per mile for each
mile traveled on trips from any point within the
County to a point outside the County in the discharge
of his official duties in full for the use of his
own vehicle used in such travel or for the use of a
vehicle hired or rented and used in the discharge of
his official duties. If such travel be by any public
conveyance, he shall be allowed the actual cost of
transportation. Where a motor vehicle is supplied
by the County and the cost of operation and upkeep
thereof paid by the County, no allowance for mileage
shall be paid to or received by any officer or employee
but only the actual cost of maintenance while traveling.
