## COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 175

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1(a). County Ordinance No. 173 is hereby repealed; Section 1(b). County Ordinance No. 151 is hereby amended by deleting therefrom Sections 2, 3, 4, and 5, and by substituting therefor the following Sections, to-wit:

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of the Conservation and Planning Law, there is hereby created a Mariposa County Planning Commission.

Section 3. The Mariposa County Planning Commission shall consist of seven members, at least one from each Supervisorial District, not officials of the county, to be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors with their approval. Members shall be appointed so as to provide adequate agricultural representation.

Section 4. Present terms of office of the members of the Planning Commission appointed to the five offices created by County Ordinance No. 151, shall not be altered hereby. The terms of office of the two additional members to be appointed hereunder shall expire on January 1st, 1958. Appointments to fill vacancies occurring prior to expiration of terms of office, shall be for the balance of the unexpired term. Successors shall be appointed for terms of four years immediately succeeding expired terms of office.

Section 5. The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, with who their approval, may appoint two ex-officio members,/shall be County Officers, and whose terms shall correspond with their official tenure as such county officers. The Chairman of the Board of Supervisors with their approval, may appoint from time to time such advisory members as shall be necessary or useful in conducting the work of the commission. Said advisory members must be County Officers or employees and shall serve for terms corresponding to their official tenures as such.

Section 6. Ex-officio and advisory members shall not be entitled to vote.

Section 7. All members of the commission shall serve without compensation, except that they shall be allowed travelling expenses to and from their usual places of business to the place of meeting of the commission, and such other travelling expenses as are allowed by law.
