TOWN HALL MEETING regarding TEMPORARY DEBRIS STORAGE AND REDUCTION OPERATION IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

On Tuesday, August 16, 2016 the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 16-448 approving and authorizing a short term log storage, sorting and reduction operation (also referred to as a "Temporary Debris Sorting and Reduction Operation" or "Operation") on APN 015-030-011, 3269 East Westfall Road. This action was taken by the Board in response to the on-going tree mortality disaster, to protect the health and safety of residents within the disaster area and to protect critical access and communications infrastructure. The Board found this Operation serves a critical and immediate public need. The Operation was proposed by PG&E, which contracted with Phillips and Jordan to conduct operations to remove tree mortality debris from PG&E easements. A notice sent to you dated August 10, 2016 contains a vicinity map and site layout for the Operation.

As a result of public input received on August 16, 2016, the Board of Supervisors directed staff to schedule regular town hall meetings to continue the discussion with the community and PG&E regarding the Operation. The purpose of the town hall meetings are:

- 1) to provide a forum for the community to receive updated and on-going information about the operation, and
- 2) to provide additional opportunities for property owners and residents to express their concerns to Supervisors and PG&E about the Operation.

A town hall meeting has been scheduled as follows:
