RE: Approve and Accept the 2016 Office of Homeland Security Grant Program (OHSGP) Application

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Adopt a Resolution Accepting the 2016 Office of Homeland Security Grant Program (OHSGP) through the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES). Revenue and Appropriations have been included in the Fiscal Year 2016/2017 Requested Budget, OHSGP Fund (445) in the amount of \$93,149.

The Office of Homeland Security Grant Program (OHSGP) is an annual grant program that requires no matching Mariposa County funds. The OHSGP provides funding for three (3) Mariposa County Departments; Sheriff's Office, County Fire Department and the Health Department.

The 2016 OHSGP funding will be directed to support the Health's Department Safety and Aid For Everyone (S.A.F.E.) Program, Sheriff's Office and County's Emergency Operations Center Extra-Help employee.

The 2016 OHSGP funding will be applied to the 2016-2017 Office of Homeland Security Grant Program Fund (445) revenue and expense lines for management of the 2016 OHSGP.

Once again, the 2016 OHSGP Grant Assurances are not available from the State and will follow once they have been received. According to Cal OES the Grant Assurances are not likely to be received before October, which forces local government to review/approve the grant prior to receiving the Grant Assurances.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Mariposa County Board of Supervisors has approved this grant in past years.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

The County would need to fund the Mariposa County Department's programs/upgrades with Mariposa County General Funds in order to continue with these enhancements.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Revenue and appropriations in the Office of Homeland Security Grant Program Fund (445) have been included in the FY 16-17 Budget.
