RE: Contract with Alliance for Community Transformations to Provide Transportation for Victims of Crime

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve a Two-Year Agreement with Alliance for Community Transformations to provide transportation for Mariposa County residents who are victims of crime in an amount not to exceed \$76,308; and authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to sign the Agreement.

The goal of this Agreement is to assist victims of crime by providing transportation to court appearances, witness interviews, and other necessary appointments related to the legal process. Victims may receive transportation to additional services that will support them in participating in the court process and in fulfilling their basic physical needs, as well as accessing health and mental health care.

Alliance will provide monthly reports to Mariposa County Human Services reflecting the numbers of individuals served and the types and numbers of services provided. In addition, other reports will be submitted as required by the California Office of Emergency Services.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

This is a new agreement with Alliance to provide transportation for Mariposa County victims of crime.

The Board authorized submission of the County Victim Services Program Grant on May 24, 2016 by Resolution 2016-252. The Board authorized acceptance of the County Victim Services Program Grant on September 27, 2016 by Resolution 2016-516.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this Agreement is not approved, Mariposa County residents who are victims of crime will not receive assistance with transportation and other needs provided under this Agreement. In addition, Mariposa County will be out of compliance with the terms of the Victim Services Grant.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This contract will be paid in the Victim Services Fund 447 Budget with grant funds received for this purpose. There is no impact to the County General Fund.
