A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING JOHN CARRIER FOR HIS
OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE COUNTY OF MARIPOSA**

WHEREAS, JOHN CARRIER was elected to the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors in November of 2012 and took office in January of 2013, served as Board Vice-Chair in 2015 and as Board Chair in 2016; and

WHEREAS, JOHN served as Vice-Chair of the Mariposa County Water Agency Board of Directors, elected Vice President of the Yosemite-Sequoia Resource Conservation Development Council, Elected as Chair of YARTS and President of the Mariposa County Public Financing Corporation; and

WHEREAS, JOHN served the County on the following committees: Area 12 Agency on Aging, Community Corrections Partnership, Fish Camp Town Planning Advisory Committee, Mariposa County Safety Committee, Wawona Town Planning Advisory Committee, and attended Yosemite West Planning Advisory Committee meetings for Supervisor Stetson of District I during a temporary medical leave; and

WHEREAS, JOHN served the County on the following agencies: Director of CSAC, served as the official host of the San Joaquin Valley Regional Association of California Counties annual conference, representative of the Mountain Valley Emergency Medical Services Agency and Regional Advisory Board, representative of San Joaquin Valley Regional Association of California Counties, and Yosemite Area Regional Transportation System (YARTS); and

WHEREAS, JOHN served as Board Liaison member for General Government, and Justice System Services, he participated in water issues and policies, Yosemite National Park Service issues, and attended Yosemite Gateway Partners meetings; and

WHEREAS, JOHN tirelessly worked on issues pertaining to the following County projects: various letters of support and opposition for pertinent types of legislation, fuel load reduction projects, road maintenance projects, General Plan/Zoning Amendments, Williamson Act/historical parcels, Yosemite West Community Planning, SilverTip Resort project, improvements to community parks, implement use of Action Minute format for the Board of Supervisors meeting minutes, the establishment of a separate Clerk of the Board department, and the selection of the County Administrative Officer, Health Officer, Public Works Department Director, Human Services Director, and Human Resources Director/Risk Manager; and

WHEREAS, JOHN helped contend with the impacts of damages associated with the horrific Rim Fire in 2013, the many fires of 2014 known as the El Portal Fire, the Meadow Fire, the Dark Hole Fire, the Bridge Fire, and the Dog Rock Fire, the Tree Mortality disaster that is devastating the County, and the current severe drought conditions; and

WHEREAS, JOHN will enjoy his retirement spending time with his wife Barbara, their children and their grandchildren, doing all the things they love to do together including fishing, hiking, snow skiing and camping.
