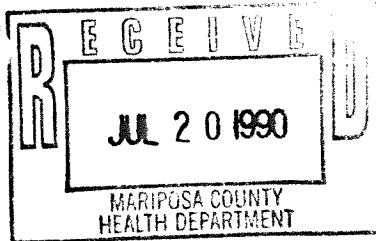

Dear Dr. Mosher:

Our Association would like to offer a sample of goat cheeses and yogurts to the general public at our Mariposa County Fair. We are not selling any products. We just want the public to be aware of the great dairy products made with goat milk.

The cheeses and yogurts will be donated to us from the Redwood Hills Farm - 10855 Occidental Rd., Sebastopol, CA 95472. Their products are made from pasturized goat milk. Which are sold in grocery stores and health food stores in California.

The products will come to the fairgrounds just before 2:00 PM on Saturday, Sept. 1, 1990. They will be in ice chests in sealed containers. Hard cheeses will be cubed in small amounts in zip lock bags. Then placed onto paper plates and a toothpick in each cube and covered with a net tent. Soft cheeses will be spread onto crackers as people want a sample. Yogurts will be offered in sample size from the Redwood Hills Farm with a new plastic spoon.

All samples will remain in ice chests until as needed for distribution to the public.

The samples will be at a table covered with a clean plastic table cloth. Members serving samples will be in fresh clean clothes using latex gloves. If there is any further health precautions we should take please advise us so we can comply.

Enclosed is our request for Food Handling Permit. I understand there is a \$30.00 permit fee. Since, we are a non-profit organization and will be handling the food for only 3 hours, I would like to request that the permit fee be waived and be exempt from the fee charges.

This is going to be an exciting time for our organization at the Fair this year. We will have our own barn and show ring. With so many other changes in the goat division this presentation of the goat cheeses will be like a little celebration. Your approval and exemption of fee will be very welcome and much appreciated.
