RESOLUTION 90-446

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING OCTOBER 1-5, 1990 AS RIDESHARE WEEK AND WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 3, 1990 AS KEEP CALIFORNIA MOVING DAY

WHEREAS, the use of ridesharing as a means of transportation in California has the potential to reduce fuel consumption, air pollution, traffic congestion, transportation costs and parking needs; and,

WHEREAS, the public and private business community throughout California has recognized the importance of ridesharing as an effective, low-cost solution to many transportation and environmental issues; and,

WHEREAS, Mariposa County's residents travel significant distances due to the rural nature and low population density of the County; and,

WHEREAS, transit services in Mariposa County, though available, are not convenient for all purposes; and,

WHEREAS, Mariposa County residents are renown for their neighborliness and ability to work together; and

WHEREAS, ridesharing coordination services are available to County residents at little cost, through the Merced County Association of Governments at (209) 722-CARS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that October 1-5, 1990 be designated as Rideshare Week and Wednesday, October 3rd, 1990 be designated as Keep California Moving Day, in Mariposa County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mariposa County residents be urged to participate by: sharing a ride, using transit services, walking or biking, or working at home, instead of

driving alone on Wednesday, October 3rd, 1990.




