WHEREAS, the applicant, Bernard McDaniel, has petitioned Mariposa County for the creation of Montaña de Paz Zone of Benefit, in association with his Final Map for Montaña de Paz; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, through Resolution No. 90-499, filed a Resolution of Intention to form a Zone of Benefit, as required by Government Code Section 25210.32, and set a date and time for a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, on November 27, 1990, the Board of Supervisors held a duly noticed public hearing on the question of forming the Montaña de Paz Zone of Benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, received no dissenting public input at the public hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, that the Board hereby approves the creation of the MONTAÑA DE PAZ ZONE OF BENEFIT, as described and shown on attached STATEMENT OF ZONE CREATION.



Zone of Benefit

The Public Works Department has prepared the following discussion and schedules associated with the formation of the Montaña de Paz Zone of Benefit. The zone being considered under this application is the result of a petition filed as a condition of approval of the Final Map for Montaña de Paz (submitted under major subdivision application No. 3-27-90). This department, as well as the planning department, is recommending the approval of this zone.

This major subdivision application has proposed a sixteen (16) lot division of the applicant's eighty five (85.76) acre parcel. The applicant has petitioned the County to form a zone of benefit for road maintenance on Montaña de Oro Drive, built as a condition of the Major Subdivision. The application was sent to County Counsel and the Planning Department for review and comment.

As required by Public Works' application process, the applicant has provided the County with an estimate (see attached estimates from S.P. Allison) for the road maintenance on this subdivision road. These estimates propose yearly costs of three thousand sixty dollars (\$3160.00). Our policy has been to increase the estimate by 10% to allow for inflationary cost increases; and then add 5% for an emergency contingency fund. The schedule below, titled "FEE SCHEDULE TO INITIATE THIS ZONE OF BENEFIT" summarizes the estimate, the County's administrative surcharge, and the State Board of Equalization filing fees. Additionally, the final figure in the schedule lists the amount to be assessed to each of the parcels, on a yearly basis, during the first year assessed (1991).
