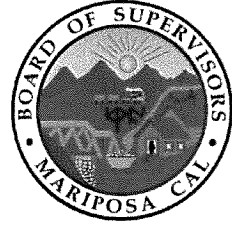

RE: Approve Budget Action for Charter School Bus - \$14,184.00

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve Budget Action Allocating Revenues and Expenses for the Grant Purchase of a Propane School Bus for Sierra Foothill Charter School (\$14,184).

The County, as the Grantee on behalf of Sierra Foothill Charter School (SFCS), received Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) funding to purchase a new alternative fuel propane powered school bus. SFCS will provide matching funds of \$14,184. This budget action allows for all necessary transactions to purchase the bus and transfer ownership to SFCS.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board accepted a bid for \$123,660.00 with Resolution LTC-17-3 on February 7, 2017. This budget action adjusts the level of grant funding and expenditures per the accepted bid and allows for the receipt of a \$14,184.00 match from SFCS.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Negative action would cause an inability to receive payment from SFCS and would require Board direction for alternative method of payment.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is no financial impact to the County associated with this project.
