

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 85-40

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING EDUCATIONAL INCENTIVE BENEFITS TO
MIDDLE MANAGEMENT MEMBERS OF THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors, a political subdivision of the State of California, entered into an agreement with the Mariposa County Deputy Sheriff's Association; and

WHEREAS, this agreement extended educational incentive benefits to deputies and did not include middle management members of the Sheriff's Department; and

WHEREAS, middle management members of the Sheriff's Department have requested the same educational incentive benefits be extended to them;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County that educational incentive benefits, as outlined in the agreement entered into with the Mariposa County Deputy Sheriff's Association, be extended to Tom Strickland, Pelk Richards, Rod Sinclair, and Dave Beavers, of the Sheriff's Department;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, that the educational benefits be extended retroactive to July 1, 1984.
