ATTACHMENT "A"

OEO PROGRAM CONCEPT

"NATIVE AMERICAN CRAFT COOPERATIVE"

PURPOSE:

Provide seed money for establishment of craft business development enterprise.

PROGRAM RESOURCES:

The program would utilize the OEO funds, in conjunction with JTPA program resources, to contract with the American Indian Council of Mariposa County (AICMC) as program operator.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The program, to be operated by AICMC, is designed to establish a craft co-op with a central retail outlet located in the community of Mariposa. In conjunction with the retail outlet, the program will employ a full-time program coordinator. Another program support element involves a training program offered through the JTPA program. Training courses will cover basic business management subjects (bookkeeping, inventory control, salesmanship, etc.) for a projected 30 project participants.

PROGRAM GOALS:

- A. To provide retail craft cooperative outlet for 30 local native american craftsman.
- B. To provide at least 80 hours of basic business management classroom instruction to 30 program participants.

EXPECTED PROGRAM RESULTS:

As a direct result of this seed money, and other resources, being provided to establish this craft cooperative, it is expected that 30 low income individuals will be able to improve their basic business management skills. As this program, the Native American Craft Cooperative, is a for-profit venture, the seed money provided by OEO should result in the program becoming self-sufficient in future years.
