BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Elections Code Section 23556, said appointees take office at noon on the last Friday in November.





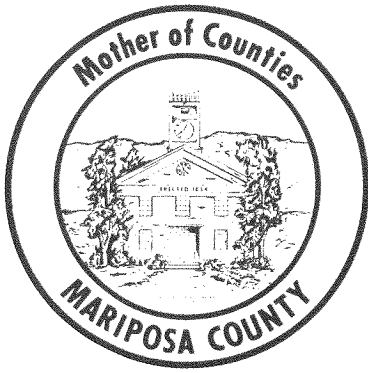
