

MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 85-365

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT RECORDS, DOCUMENTS, AND PAPERS, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 26202.6 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has submitted a request for authority to destroy obsolete records; and

WHEREAS, said request is in accordance with the procedures and requirements of Sections 26202 and 26202.6 of the California Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has stipulated the useful retention period for the Sheriff's Department records;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Mariposa County, a political subdivision of the State of California, as follows:

1. The following County records, documents, instruments, books, or papers are no longer required and may be destroyed:

- a. Sheriff's civil documents dated prior to 1981;
- b. Sheriff's prisoner files of deceased subjects;
- c. Sheriff's daily business ledgers dated prior to 1975;
- d. Sheriff's vehicle abatement records;
- e. Sheriff's warrant cards which have been recalled by the Court;
- f. Sheriff's Department oral board results prior to 1980;
- g. Sheriff's cash receipt books prior to 1981;
- h. Sheriff's closed vehicles files;
- i. Sheriff's outdated training material;
- j. Sheriff's bail receipt books dated prior to 1981;

k. Sheriff's copies of dealers records of sale (revolvers and pistols) prior to 1981; and

l. Sheriff's old vehicle maintenance reports.




