


MARIPOSA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 85-399

A RESOLUTION WAIVING BIDDING PROCEDURE FOR PURCHASE OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT
TO BE SHARED BY AGRICULTURE COMMISSIONER AND FARM ADVISOR


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Mariposa County Board of Supervisors finds it in the best public interest to waive the formal bidding procedures for the purchase of computer equipment as described on Exhibit A, to be shared by the Agriculture Commissioner and the Farm Advisor, based on the following findings: Computer equipment is being purchased by the State through the State's purchasing procedure and the County is reimbursing the State for the County's share of computer cost, and equipment is compatible with existing State equipment.

Dear Don Cripe:

Enclosed is your amended 1985/86 pesticide enforcement contract. This contract has been increased, for this year only, by \$ 3,500. The total amount payable under this agreement shall not exceed \$ 4,700.

The purpose of this one-time increase is to allow the county agricultural commissioner to participate in a 50 percent cost share of a microcomputer with the county farm advisor. The equipment to be shared should be ordered by the advisor on the Cooperative Extension's form MF11. The equipment to be ordered includes: a Quime 108 terminal, a Diablo companion T232CQ1 dot matrix printer, a RAM 22 board, a disc 3 controller, and a Quantim 50 40-mgh hard disc with enclosure.
