RE: First Amendment - Jane Norwood Agreement with Human Services

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve First Amendment to Agreement with Jane Norwood to provide Consulting Services for Mariposa County Human Services, increasing agreement amount by \$40,000 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$60,000; and authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to sign the Amendment.

The current agreement with Jane Norwood has a term from September 1, 2017, to December 31, 2018, with a not-to-exceed amount of \$20,000.

Jane Norwood is well versed in child welfare, client services and systems. We have benefited from her involvement in the research and development of both the Child Welfare Services/Probation County Self- Assessment and Self-Improvement Plan. She brings a wealth of knowledge and experience that support these endeavors. Her services make a tremendous difference in helping staff to meet State of California requirements and ultimately provide better client services.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The County Administrative Officer approved the current agreement with Jane Norwood on November 20, 2017.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If this Agreement is not approved, Human Services will not have the benefit of Jane Norwood's services.
