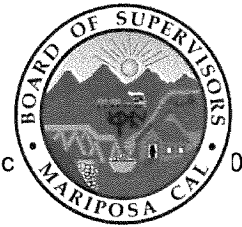

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve Amendment one to Agreement 12-89374 A01 to the existing multi-year Agreement (12-89374) with the State Department of Health Care Services authorizing Mariposa County Behavioral Health to provide specialty mental health services; and authorize the Human Services Director to sign the Amendment.

This amendment will only change the end date of the prior contract from April 30, 2018 to June 30, 2017 because many of the requirements in the updated Medicaid Managed Care regulations became effective retroactively and applicable on July 1, 2017.

This contract amends a performance agreement with the State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) which enables Mariposa County Behavioral Health to serve Medi-Cal Beneficiaries and claim Medi-Cal reimbursement. The term of this Agreement is May 1, 2013 through June 30, 2017.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The existing Agreement (12-89374) was approved by the Board on August 7, 2012, Resolution 2013-71.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Without this Agreement in place, Behavioral Health will be unable to serve Medi-Cal beneficiaries and claim Medi-Cal reimbursement.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Under this Agreement, Behavioral Health provides services to Medi-Cal beneficiaries and receives reimbursement. This Agreement provides the primary revenue source for Behavioral Health. There is no impact on the general fund.
