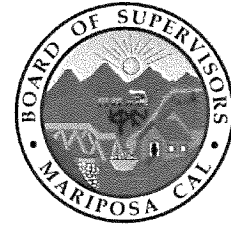

RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2019-24

RE: Ratify Agreement for Use of Subscription Material with Lexipol

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Ratify the Sheriff's Signature on the Agreement for Use of Subscription Material with Lexipol for Agency Wide Policy Management and Training Platforms.

By the Sheriff entering into this agreement prior to December 1, 2018, the Sheriff's Office will receive a thirty-five percent discount, amounting to a savings of \$23,400.00 dollars.

Lexipol is America's leading provider of policy management and training platforms for public safety organizations. Lexipol offers policy management solutions to more than 3,300 agencies in 35 states. Lexipol's content is continuously updated to address legislative changes and evolving best practices. Using accountability tools and integrated training, Lexipol provides a cost-effective way for agencies to enhance policy compliance and understanding, allowing leaders to focus more resources on serving their communities.

The attached agreement outlines the services Lexipol will provide to the Mariposa County Sheriff's Office. A one time fee of \$44,100.00 dollars will be the full implementation of Lexipol; integrating and updating all Mariposa Sheriff's Office policies and procedures for both patrol and custody divisions.

An annual subscription for Lexipol services will be pro-rated at \$9,878.00 dollars for December 2018 through June 30, 2019. Continuing Lexipol services through FY 19/20 will have an annual cost of \$12,976.00 dollars.

The Lexipol Services Agreement is being pursued to expedite the process of updating current policies and procedures, to include best practices as well as ever evolving case law, mitigating risk, liability and costs associated with out-of-date or incomplete policies.

There is no immediate impact to the General Fund for the initial implementation as all fees associated with this agreement will be paid through the Sheriff's Office RCCP grant funding. However, the Sheriff is interested that future Lexipol annual agreement fees will be supported by the Sheriff's FY budget supported by the BOS.

All Fees are defined in the Agreement. No Impact to General Fund as all fees for the initial implementation an first year annual subscriptoin will be paid through the Sheriff's Office RCCP grant funding.
