RE: Authorize Public Works to Waive the Encroachment Permit Fee of \$140 for the Paseo De Mariposa Run

### RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Authorize Public Works to Waive the Encroachment Permit Fee of \$140 for the Paseo De Mariposa 5K & Run / Walk and 12K Run on May 4, 2019, in Conjunction with the Butterfly Festival; and Authorize the Board of Supervisors to Sponsor the Event for Insurance Purposes.

The purpose of the Paseo de Mariposa event is to increase awareness of free, outdoor physical activities available in Mariposa County for community residents, especially women and children.

This event will be a 5K run/walk and a 12K run held in the Mariposa town site with the start/stop location in front of the historical Courthouse. The trail run course includes the Mariposa Public Utilities District (MPUD) reservoir trail, the Flume Trail, Slaughterhouse Road and private property.

### BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On March 8, 2016 Resolution 2016-108 the Board approved the Paseo de Mariposa 5K run/walk as a County Sponsored Event, in conjunction with the Butterfly Festival.

### ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not authorize Public Works department to waive the encroachment permit fee. The event organizers will need to pay for the encroachment permit fee, which may cause a hardship since the event is being sponsored by volunteers and it is not intended to be a money making event.
