RE: Approve California Complete Count Census Agreement and Authorize the Board Chair to Sign

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve California Complete Count Census Agreement; and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Agreement.

On February 5th, 2019, the Letter of Agreement was approved Informing the California Complete Count Census 2020 that Mariposa County Elects to Opt-In to the County-Optional Outreach Effort. Additional approval is required because the contract covers a period of more than twelve months.

The California Complete Count Census 2020 effort is a statewide outreach and awareness campaign designed to ensure an accurate and complete count of all Californians in the upcoming 2020 United States Census. The 2020 Census is the decennial census, mandated by Article 1, Section 2 of the United States Constitution. The results are used to allocate Congressional seats, electoral votes, and government program funding to state and local governments. Just based on the funding component, a census that undercounts Californians could cost the state billions of dollars. For every Californian missed during the Census 2020 count, the State is expected to lose approximately \$1,950 per person, per year, for 10 years, in federal program funding.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On February 5th, 2019 (2019-77), the Board approved the Letter of Agreement Informing the California Complete Count Census 2020 that Mariposa County Elects to Opt-In to the County-Optional Outreach Effort and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to Sign the Letter of Agreement. Mariposa County Will Receive \$25,000 to Support Census Outreach Efforts in the County.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve the agreement and authorize the Board chair to sign and do not participate in the Complete Count Census program.

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FINANCIAL IMPACT:

A budget action was approved on February 5, 2019 (2019-77).
