4 WHEREAS, the County of San Joaquin has with financial assis-  
5 tance from the California Council on Criminal Justice been  
6 developing a system of computerization of criminal justice informa-  
7 tion and,

8 WHEREAS, the system, as developed, can be modified to  
9 accommodate all law enforcement and criminal justice agencies  
10 throughout the counties of San Joaquin, Stanislaus, Merced, and  
11 Mariposa, and

12 WHEREAS, in so doing the efficiency and effectiveness of all  
13 agencies within the region will be strengthened and,

14 WHEREAS, it is proposed that the system be expanded and at  
15 a future date, offered to the other entities within the region  
16 and,

17 WHEREAS, it is necessary to have an expression of interest on  
18 the part of the entities who are potential users of the system,

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that insofar as allowed by  
20 law, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa does here-  
21 by express its intent to cooperate fully with San Joaquin County,  
22 the California Council on Criminal Justice, and Region K of CCCJ  
23 in the implementation of said regional system and,

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that since the financial and other  
25 resources of Mariposa County are not fully known at this time,  
26 this Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa hereby re-  
27 serves the right to refuse to participate if such demands are ex-  
28 cessive.
