Gentlemen:


In that retirement of my former secretary will leave excess in my budget for Salaries and Employee Benefits of \$918.00, I am requesting Board authorization for the following:
Transfer from Salaries and Employee Benefits to Fixed Assets Account for purchase of offset duplicator and overhead projector of \$450.00;
Transfer from Salaries and Employee Benefits to Office Supplies of \$250.00;
Transfer from Salaries and Employee Benefits to Special Departmental of \$50.00;
Transfer from Salaries and Employee Benefits to Maintenance and Equipment of \$100.00;
Transfer from Salaries and Employee Benefits to Communications of \$68.00.

I have a once in a lifetime opportunity to purchase an offset duplicator, an office machine which one can not only use like a mimeograph, but with which actual print-like reproductions can be made such as ones own letterheads, self-mailers or copies of photographs or other already printed material. Such equipment should enable office to keep up with ever increasing work load in more efficient manner. I propose to purchase this machine, Multilith Model 85, from the University of California. It is currently in use at San Joaquin Valley Research and Extension Center near Parlier. It is surplus only because the Center is in need of larger capacity machine. The cost new was \$1500.00 and same model reconditioned costs \$1200.00. One not reconditioned or traded in brings minimum of \$750.00. I can purchase it for \$200.00.

Also, to further aid this office in educational efforts, I should like to purchase an overhead projector (portable) as an adjunct to my visual aid equipment.

The remainder of the transfers are for purpose of augmenting those budget items which have been depleted beyond planned amounts due to emergencies or unpredicted needs -- also to purchase some supplies for new equipment.
