AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into this 20th day of February, 1973, between the County of Mariposa, hereinafter called COUNTY, and the Mariposa Public Utility District, hereinafter called DISTRICT; each of which is a political subdivision of the State of California, is made in view of the following:

WHEREAS pursuant to the joint powers provision of the California Government Code (Sections 6500 through 6514), the parties have entered into this agreement; and

WHEREAS the DISTRICT has entered into an agreement with the California Division of Forestry to provide mutual aid fire protection, as shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, which is under the responsibility of the County of Mariposa; and

WHEREAS the COUNTY has entered into a contract with the California Division of Forestry to provide 24-hour fire dispatch services for all COUNTY volunteer fire departments; and

WHEREAS the DISTRICT's fire department's radio is operating on the COUNTY's radio frequency, which is incompatible with the California Division of Forestry's frequency;

THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED between the parties hereto as follows:

I

The COUNTY agrees to grant to the DISTRICT the sum of Seven Hundred and <sup>no</sup> /100 to be used for the purpose of converting the DISTRICT's radio equipment to a system which will be compatible with the California Division of Forestry's

1 radio system.

2 II

3 In consideration therefor, the DISTRICT agrees to pro-  
4 vide mutual fire protection pursuant to their agreement with the  
5 California Division of Forestry for the area described in Exhibit  
6 A.

7 III

8 In the event that the mutual aid contract between the  
9 DISTRICT and California Division of Forestry is terminated, the  
10 DISTRICT agrees to convert its radio communication system back  
11 to the COUNTY's frequency at no cost to the COUNTY.

12 IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto pursuant to  
13 resolutions of their respective governing boards have caused this  
14 joint powers agreement to be executed this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February,  
15 1973.

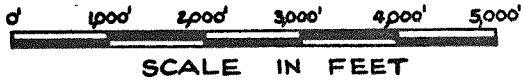
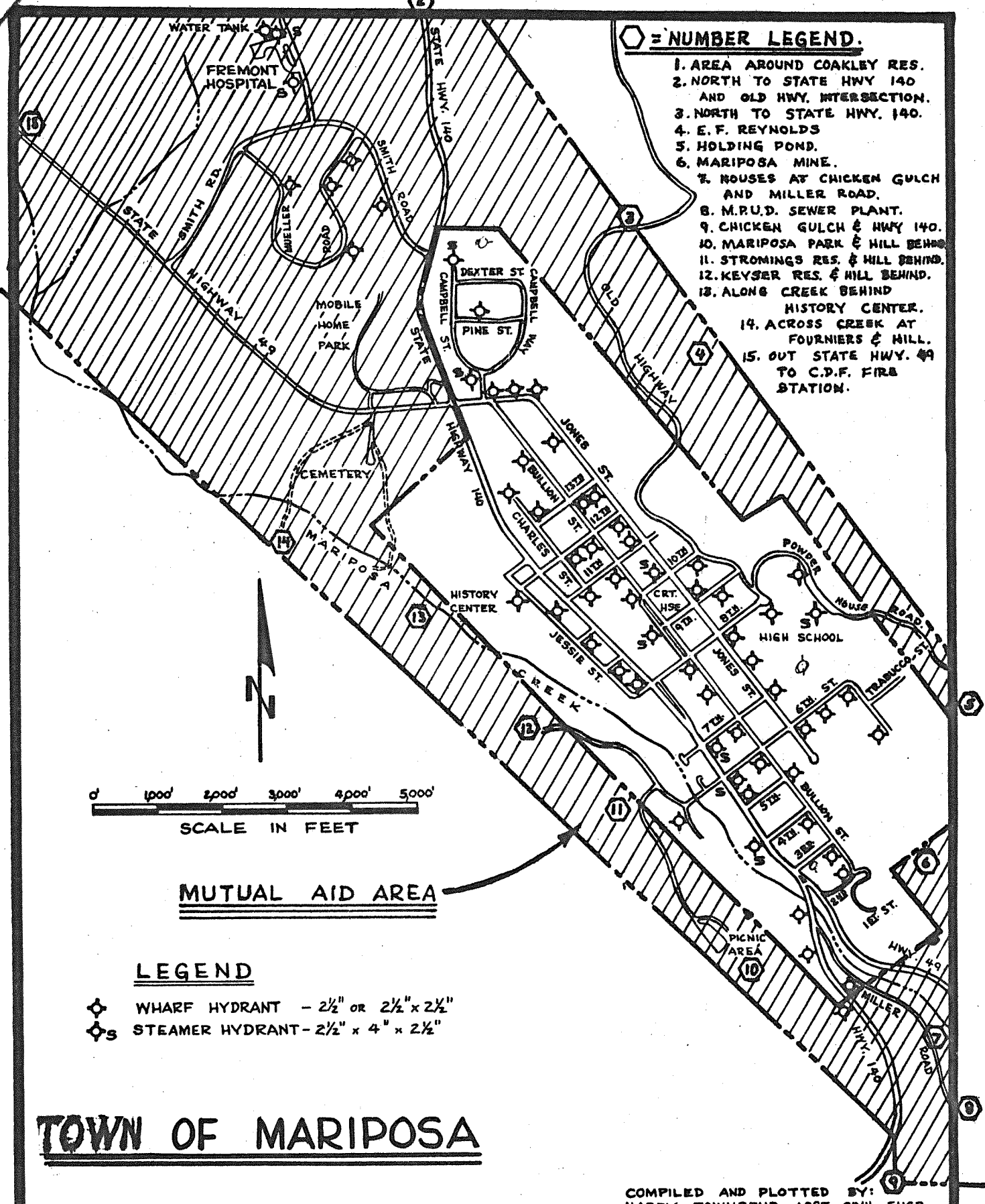
