WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has instituted proceedings for the establishment of a county service area within a portion of the unincorporated territory of the County of Mariposa, commonly known as Section 35, Township 4 South, Range 21 East, M.D.B. & M; and

WHEREAS, the formation of a county service area for the hereinafter stated purpose has been approved by the Mariposa County Local Agency Formation Commission; and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for <sup>continued</sup> public hearing on the 13th day of March, 1973, at the hour of 2:00 P.M. in the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors, Mariposa County Courthouse, and due and proper notice was given of such hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, said hearing was duly and regularly held at the time and place appointed on the 13th day of March, 1973; and

WHEREAS, this Board has found that all proceedings prior to this Resolution were valid and in conformity with the requirements of the County Service Area Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a county service area is hereby established which shall be known and designated as "COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 2W."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, declared, finally determined and established that the boundaries of said County Service

Area are as set forth in said Resolution of Intention and in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is found and declared that the types of service to be provided in said County Service Area are as shown in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein; that said services are further found and declared to be extended county services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be filed with the Assessor of the County of Mariposa, the Auditor of the County of Mariposa, State Board of Equalization and for record in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Mariposa.

EXHIBIT "A"

The area to be included in the proposed County Service Area  
is described as follows:

Section 35 of Mariposa County, being all  
of that land situated within the boundaries  
of said Section 35, Township 4 South, Range  
21 East, MDB&M, comprising 640 acres, more  
or less.

EXHIBIT "B"

1. Extended police protection.
2. Structural fire protection.
3. Local park, recreation or parkway facilities, and services.
4. Extended library facilities and services.
5. Television translator station facilities and services, provided, however, that:
  - A. The number of translators to be erected by the service area will not exceed three; and
  - B. The number of television channels provided by the service area will not exceed three.
6. Miscellaneous extended services as follows:
  - a) Water service including the acquisition, construction, operation, replacement, maintenance and repair of water supply and distribution systems, including land, easements and rights of way and water rights.
  - b) Sewer service, including the acquisition, construction, operation, replacement, maintenance and repair of sewage collection, transportation and disposal systems, including land, easements and rights of way.
  - c) Pest or rodent control.
  - d) Street and highway sweeping.
  - e) Street and highway lighting including the acquisition, construction, replacement, maintenance and repair of a street or highway lighting system, including land, easements and rights of way.
  - f) Refuse collection.
  - g) Garbage collection.
