3 BE IT RESOLVED that Resolutions No. 70-60, 71-73, 72-1,
4 72-5, 72-26, 72-63, 73-2, 73-56 are hereby repealed.

5 IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that employees, except persons under
6 contract or serving by special agreement, elective and appointive
7 officials listed in Mariposa County Ordinance No. 367, and Road
8 Department employees compensated at an hourly rate, shall be paid
9 monthly according to the following 8-step salary range classifi-
10 cation plan, with each employee entering employment at the first
11 step of the salary range classification provided for his or her
12 employment or such step thereof as the Board of Supervisors shall
13 by minute order designate at or after the time of hiring, to wit:

26 All present officers and employees of the Department of Social Wel-
27 fare shall retain their existing anniversary dates and step assign-
28 ments, although the Board of Supervisors may, by Minute Order or

1 Resolution, make necessary step assignments within a five range
2 in order to place all officers and employees in the top five
3 steps of the range classification. New employees may be recruited
4 at a lower salary range and job classification than those set
5 forth in this resolution.
