

Resolution No. 73-120

WHEREAS, the Special Election held on November 6, 1973, concerned only with the Governor's TAX INITIATIVE PROPOSAL, PROPOSITION NO. I, unduly and unnecessarily burdened the County of Mariposa with substantial costs and expenses; and

WHEREAS, under the Mandates of SB90 of the 1972 Legislative Session the State of California is required to reimburse the County of Mariposa for the costs of any new programs foisted upon the County by the State; and

WHEREAS, the Special Election held on November 6, 1973, was called by the Honorable Ronald Reagan, Governor, acting in his official capacity,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mariposa that reimbursement for the costs to the County of Mariposa of the Special Election held November 6, 1973, be made forthwith by the State of California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by this Board that the Clerk and Auditor of the County of Mariposa be and are hereby directed to make a proper claim for said reimbursement to the State of California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board that the Clerk of the Board be and she is hereby directed to send forthwith duly certified copies of this Resolution to the Honorable Eugene Chappie, Assemblyman and to the Honorable Howard Way, State Senator, a member of the National Council of Rural Societies.
