RE: Approve Extra Help Additional Hours from 999 to 1100 for Two Sheriff's Deputy Recruits

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Increase extra-help hours from 999 to 1,100 for two extra-help Sheriff's Deputy Recruits employed by the Sheriff's Office.

The two Sheriff's Deputy Recruits are attending the Police Academy and are scheduled to graduate on June 28, 2019. In order for these two Recruits to complete their training, it will be necessary for them to exceed the 999 hour threshold as Academy training requires more than 999 hours of training and testing.

Extra-Help positions can work up to 860 hours. The Human Resources Director can approve additional hours up to 999 hours because of need. Any hours above 999 requires Board approval.

No financial impact to the General Fund as this cost will be absorbed by the Sheriff's Office extra-help line.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board has previously approved the increase of extra-help hours for other positions.
