RE: Authorize the Public Works Director to Award Contracts for the Storm Events of 2019

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Authorize the Public Works Director to Solicit Bids and Award Construction Contracts to initiate Permanent Infrastructure Repairs Associated with the March 2019 Storm Events, Subject to Approval as to Form by County Counsel.

As the Board of Supervisors is well aware, our region was the victim of storm activity during the month of March 2019 which caused damage to critical infrastructure. In many cases, the damage far exceeds the staffing availability and County owned equipment for County staff to effect repairs in a prompt and efficient manner.

The Board of Supervisors directed that repairs to restore transportation infrastructure be accomplished using private contracting resources as the amount of work far exceed the availability of internal resources.

Staff is seeking the identical authority from the Board that was granted to the Director, Public Works & Transportation with respect to the emergency repairs and that is to solicit and accept bids, award and execute agreements upon approval as to form by County Counsel. Staff seeks this authority as it is our intention to do all that we can to move as many of these projects forward.

As with the previous resolution the Director, Public Works & Transportation will routinely report to the Board the award of project contracts as they occur.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On March 28, 2017 Resolution 2017-163 the Board authorized Public Works to receive bids and award emergency contract for temporary repair work.

On April 3, 2018 Resolution 2018-152 the Board authorized Public Works to solicit and award emergency construction agreements.

On November 5, 2018 Resolution 2018-517 the Board authorized Public Works to

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solicit and award construction contracts for February 2017 and March 2018 for the permanent infrastructure repairs.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve, the final restorations and repairs for these roads will not be completed.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This work is funded by CalOES CDAA and will have a Local Share component which will have to be met prior to project closeout.
