RE: Advise the Board of Solid Waste Fees Waivers

9284RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Advise the Board of Supervisors of Solid Waste Fees Waivers for the Mariposa Miners Special Olympics Event and the Mariposa Bears & Cheer for the Disposal of Old Equipment.

From time to time the Department receives requests from local Community and Non-Profit Organizations to waive Solid Waste Fees associated with their community events.

While the ability of the County to contribute financially to these events is limited, granting the Director of Public Works & Transportation the authority to waive Solid Waste fees would clearly serve the public benefit by encouraging robust waste collection at these events while also allowing event organizers to focus limited resources for maximum effect.

Requests for such waivers are submitted in writing to the Director of Public Works and will typically be limited to one event per organization per calendar year.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

On May 3, 2016 Resolution 2016-216 the Board authorized the Director of Public Works & Transportation to waive Solid Waste fees for specific events.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

Do not approve, these fees could cause a hardship to the groups.

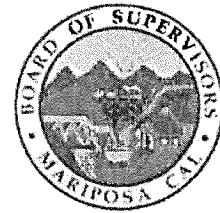

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RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2016-216

RE: Authority to Waive Solid Waste Fees

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Authorize the Public Works Director to Waive Solid Waste Fees Up to a Maximum of \$500 for Community and Non-Profit Events.

From time to time the Department receives requests from local Community and Non-Profit Organizations to waive Solid Waste Fees associated with their community events. The most recent request is from Special Olympics Northern California and the host team the Mariposa Miners, Mariposa County's Special Olympics team. The Mariposa Miners will host the Regional Track and Field event on May 7, 2016 and have requested reduction or waiver of tipping fees for disposal of waste collected during the event.

While the ability of the County to contribute financially to these events is limited, granting the Director of Public Works the authority to waive Solid Waste fees would clearly serve the public benefit by encouraging robust waste collection at these events while also allowing event organizers to focus limited resources for maximum effect.

Requests for such waivers would be submitted in writing to the Director of Public Works and would typically be limited to one event per organization per calendar year.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board has routinely waived fees for non-profit community based events in the past.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

The Board may chose to not waive fees for such events, could choose to require that waivers be approved at the Board level, or provide alternate direction.
