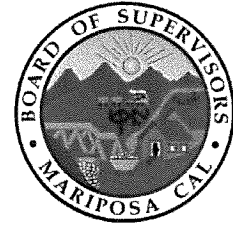

### **RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

Approve an Encroachment Permit fee waiver for a self-insured State agency (CHP) to hold a National Night Out event on August 6, 2019.

This event will be utilizing the Courthouse lawn as well as 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Streets between Bullion and Jones Streets. The event will consist of local law enforcement and public service agencies utilizing booths to reach out to the local community. The public is invited to come get to know their local service men and women with intent to tighten community relationships.

### **BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:**

National Night Out is a community-police awareness- raising event in the United States, held nationwide the first Tuesday of August. National Night Out enhances the relationship between neighbors and law enforcement while bringing back a true sense of community. Furthermore, it provides a great opportunity to bring police and neighbors together under positive circumstances. The state of Texas and select areas celebrate the first Tuesday in October.

### **ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:**

Do not approve fee waiver and use of 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Streets; a fee will need to be paid and the event may be limited to the Courthouse lawn.
