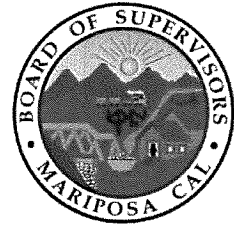

RESOLUTION - ACTION REQUESTED 2019-472

RE: Approve Contract for Services with EJM Digital, LLC

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Approve an Agreement with EJM Digital, LLC to access the mobile based Sex Offender Registration Program; and Authorize the Board of Supervisors Chair to sign the Agreement.

The current sex offender program is managed locally by Sheriff's Office staff involving in-person scheduling and single point data entry. EJM Digital, LLC provides the ODIN comprehensive sex offender management system specifically designed for those who investigate, register and supervise registered sex offenders in Mariposa County.

The ODIN system includes a web and mobile application for law enforcement personnel, as well as offender registrants. Allied agencies, such as Probation and Parole, can enjoy shared access to the ODIN system. In addition to registration and messaging capabilities, the system can also provide the offender's histories, pictures, registration events and GPS locating.

The ODIN system complies with federal and state mandates, ensures that registrants are accounted for, registered appropriately and regularly checked for compliance with applicable laws.

The system is enhanced with tools to calendar, remind, message and fully documents interviews, information, and photographs of the registrants, vehicles, homes and other pertinent data that is regularly used by enforcement agencies.

The ODIN system will be a useful tool for Mariposa County law enforcement agencies and assist in officers with their mission in maintaining a safe community.

BACKGROUND AND HISTORY OF BOARD ACTIONS:

The Board has supported proactive advancements in technology for increased public service to Mariposa County and the community.

ALTERNATIVES AND CONSEQUENCES OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If the Board does not support this item, the Sheriff's Office will continue to process sex offender registrations manually; However, the current local system is not web based.
