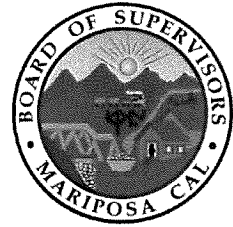

RE: Declare the Mariposa "Go West Festival" a County Sponsored Event

RECOMMENDATION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Declare the "Go West Festival" to be Held on October 19, 2019, as a County-Sponsored Event; and Waive the Encroachment Permit Fee.

The fourth annual "Go West Festival" will be staged in various areas such as the Arts Park and walkway, Stroming Road and 5th Street parking lots. The purpose of this event is to not only bring the community out and visitors in, but also highlight and educate the public on our town's colorful history. This family friendly event features events and competitions such as an "Old West" Attire Costume Contest, Gold Panning, Dummy Roping competition for kids, Native American Hoop Dancing and Native American history with basket weaving presented by the Parker family.

The event flyer advertises for a Friday night "Cowboy Poker Pub Crawl" which will not be a part of the County-sponsored event. Additionally, the local Lions Club will be sponsoring the Cornhole Competition and will be selling beer, hot dogs, and hamburgers. The Lions Club will provide insurance naming the County as an additional insured on their policy for the Cornhole Competition.
